Trophies: Section VII will provide trophies for Section Final Contests.

Ribbons: In the sports of gymnastics, swim, wrestling and track & field the section will purchase ribbons for the sectional final event. Sport Coordinators will be responsible for ordering the appropriate number of ribbons.

REGIONAL AND NYSPHSAA CHAMPIONSHIPS:

Team Sports:

The school district is responsible for making arrangements and payment for meal, lodging and transportation. To receive reimbursement the school must submit a completed Reimbursement Form to the Section VII Treasurer.

Regional contests: Section VII will provide mileage reimbursement according to the schedule below at the rate established by NYSPHSAA. Meal/lodging reimbursement will NOT be provided for contests conducted in Section 2 or Section 10.

NYSPHSAA Championships: Section VII will provide mileage reimbursement and meals/lodging reimbursement according to the schedule below. Mileage reimbursement will be provided at the rate established by NYSPHSAA.

Individual Sports:

The Section VII Sport Coordinator will make arrangements for lodging and/or transportation for the NYSPHSAA Championship and submit a detailed lodging/transportation report of the championship event to the Section VII Treasurer.

Schools receive a prorated per athlete reimbursement credit toward the total cost of the championship event based on the number of participants per school. The credit is determined by the schedule below. Reimbursement credit is not calculated for coaches and other school personnel.

The total cost of the championship event is determined by totaling expenses for transportation (minus the NYSPHSAA transportation reimbursement),

meals/lodging (based on the schedule below), and fees pertinent to that sport (lift tickets, practice rounds, banquet, etc).

NOTE: When multiple schools provide transportation for the NYSPHSAA Championship event the per athlete transportation stipend is deducted from the cost of lodging. When one school provides transportation for the section team for the NYPSHSAA Championship event that school will receive the transportation stipend.
